BYLAW NO. 216

**A Bylaw for Levying Taxes on the Land and Improvements within the District
for Fire and Street Lighting Purposes**

THE TRUSTEES of the Diamond Improvement District in open meeting assembled
ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. The sum of FIFTY-THREE THOUSAND (\$53,000.00) is required by the Improvement District for Fire Protection and Street Lighting in the year 2023.
2. A tax at a rate determined to be necessary to raise the aforesaid sum is hereby levied for the year 2023 on all land and improvements as defined in the School Act, within the Improvement District in accordance with Section 756 of the *Local Government Act*.
3. The said taxes shall be due and payable as provided in the *Taxation (Rural Area) Act* and if delinquent shall bear interest at the rate set out under the *Taxation (Rural Area) Act* until paid or recovered.
4. This bylaw may be cited as the “**Fire Protection and Street Lighting Taxation By-law 2023**”.
